

# FabScraps C92 Woodlands Friends Squirrels Gift Card

## Requirements

Standard 21cmx11cm white DL envelope  
Cardstock: white and brown  
FabScraps C92 Woodlands Friends range  
Joy! Vintage Flourish  
Tim Holtz Tea Dye distress ink  
Gauze  
Mini wooden beads  
Mini bark chip  
Gauze  
Glossy Ascents  
Sentiment tag  
Paper leaf  
Brown mini pearls

## Front

10.5cmx10.5cm brown card stock  
10cmx10cm C92 002 Woodlands  
Mini Squirrel die cut from C92 011 Mini Squirrels set  
Gauze  
Bark chip, wooden beads

## Front top flap/pouch

2 x 10.5cmx2.5cm Brown card  
10cmx2cm C92 002 Woodlands Creatures  
Mini tag, ribbon and Sentiment

## Inside Left

10.5cmx10.5cm Brown card  
10cmx10cm C92 001 It's a hoot!  
10.5cmx2.5cm Brown card  
10.5cmx2m C91 001 It's a hoot!  
Gauze, ribbon, vintage flourish die cut, paper leaf, bark chip, wooden beads

## Inside right

10.5cmx10.5cm Brown card  
10cmx10cm white card  
9.5cmx3.5cm C92 002 Woodlands creatures

## Back of card (optional)

10.5cmx10.5cm Brown card

## To make up the card

1. Fold the envelope in half ensuring that the sealed flap remains open on the outside of the envelope
2. On the outside flap (turn to face you), measure 11cm from the right hand side to the centre and snip the flap in half
3. On the left hand side (*now the back of the card*) fold up the flap and seal closed
4. Keep the right hand side seal/flap (*now the front of the card*) unsealed to form your pouch as per the steps below
5. Use your corner rounder to round each of the corners on all the pieces and then chalk edges

6. Dab your gauze with the Distress ink, spritz with water and rub between your fingers to change the colour of the gauze from white to tea colour, set aside to dry

#### **Front**

7. Measure and cut the paper piece as per the requirements for the front cover
8. Stick the C92 002 Woodlands creatures paper onto the brown card
9. Wrap the gauze around the bottom right hand corner of card pack, finishing just off centre on the right hand side of the card, stick the Vintage flourish just underneath the gauze
10. Secure the paper stack to the front of the card, add the squirrel, bark chip and wooden beads to finish off

#### **Top flap for pouch**

11. Measure and cut the paper piece as per the requirements for the top flap
12. Use your corner rounder to snip the corners of the flap
13. Stick the brown card onto the top of the flap.
14. For the underside of the flap, stick the Woodlands Creatures C92 002 paper onto the brown card and secure both the underside of the flap
15. stamp the sentiment onto the tag, pull the ribbon through the tag and secure to the top of the flap

#### **Inside left**

16. Measure and cut the paper piece as per the requirements for the inside left hand side
17. Flip over the C92 001 It's a hoot 10cmx10cm paper piece so that the words are showing and stick down onto the brown card, flip over the C92 001 It's a hoot 10cmx2.5cm paper so that the words are showing and stick down onto the brown card strip, wrap the ribbon around the strip and secure onto the 10.5cmx10.5cm card stack, secure all to the left hand side of the envelope
18. Slip the paper leaf just underneath the ribbon and glue down, glue the vintage flourish on top of the leaf, cover the bottom of the flourish with a small piece of the gauze, add the bark chip and wooden beads to finish off

#### **Inside right**

19. Measure and cut the paper piece as per the requirements for the inside right
20. Stick the white card to the brown card
21. Stick the Woodlands Creatures C92 002 paper onto the bottom of the card stack
22. Stick the paper stack onto the right hand side of the envelope

#### **Back of card (Optional)**

23. For a professional finishing touch, cut and stick down a piece of brown card onto the back of the card to hide away the folded and glued down seams of the envelope
24. Use your glossy ascents on the eyes of the Squirrels and Deer on each of the card pieces visible
25. Cut the leftover pieces of paper down to 15cmx15cm, 10cmx15cm, 10cmx10cm and 5cmx5cm pieces and place into your scrap paper storage box for later use to make greeting cards, tags or to use on your layouts. Throw away the remaining small bits and pieces. Enjoy!
